Keeping The Faith "Noah"

Genesis 6:13-22 On Campus: April 14, 2024 Online: April 21, 2024

Three Things About Noah's Faith:

1. Noah God.

So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth" (Genesis 6:13)

"I am going to bring floodwaters on the earth to destroy all life under the heavens, every creature that has the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will perish" (Genesis 6:17)

"Now no shrub had yet appeared on the earth and no plant had yet sprung up, for the LORD God had not sent rain on the earth and there was no one to work the ground, but streams came up from the earth and watered the whole surface of the ground" (Genesis 2:5-6)

The Lord then said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and your whole family, because <u>I have found you righteous in this generation</u>" (Genesis 7:1)

"As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man" (Matthew 24:37)

2. Noah _____ An Ark.

"Noah did everything just as God commanded <a href="https://hittigu.nih.gov/hi

"So make yourself an ark of <u>cypress wood</u>; make rooms in it and <u>coat it with pitch inside and out</u>. This is how you are to build it: <u>The ark is to be three hundred cubits long, fifty cubits wide and thirty cubits high</u>. Make a roof for it, leaving below the roof an opening one cubit high all around. <u>Put a door in the side of the ark and make lower, middle and upper decks</u>" (Genesis 6:14-16)

3. Noah _____ His Neighbors.

"If he did not spare the ancient world when he brought the flood on its ungodly people, but protected <u>Noah, a preacher</u> of righteousness, and seven others" (2 Peter 2:5)

"The LORD saw how great the wickedness of the human race had become on the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of the human heart was only evil all the time" (Genesis 6:5)
